SUPERBOWL & SKL CREDIT CHALLENGE 2023 1st October to 3rd November 2023 Rules & Regulations

1) Objective

This tournament is organized, hosted by SuperBowl & sponsored by SKL Credit for all bowlers to foster and maintain the spirit of good fellowship and true sportsmanship.

2) Eligibility

a) This tournament is open to all bowlers **<u>except</u>** bowlers in National squads.

b) Ex-National after 2 years as of 1st October 2023 will be allowed to participate.

3) Qualifying Details

a) This event will be based on qualifying over 3 games at any 7 SuperBowl Bowling Centre. Qualifying will be played on cross lanes (only designated lanes for MQ) with a minimum of 2 bowlers or pacer and maximum 4 bowlers to a pair (subject to lane availability).

b) SuperBowl In-House leagues score (1st 3 games) is allowed for qualifying.

c) Qualifying will be daily from opening till 10pm subject to lane availability (<u>Excluding eve and public</u> <u>holiday</u>). **RESERVATION OF LANE IS NOT ALLOWED FOR QUALIFYING.** Last sales of MQ will be at 8pm on <u>3rd November 2023.</u>

4) Playing rules

All games in the event shall be played in accordance with the Rules & Regulations of the Singapore Bowling Federation.

5) Entry fees

a) All participants are to complete the entry form together with a \$10/- registration fee <u>at any</u> <u>preferred participating SuperBowl Bowling Centre</u> and his/her scores will appear only on that registered bowling Centre standing scoreboard.

b) Registration fee is <u>not transferable</u> to other SuperBowl Bowling Centres. Participant must pay another \$10/- registration fee if he/she wishes to qualify at another bowling Centre.

6) **Qualifiers for Masters' Final**

Total 60 bowlers will bowl in the Masters' Final as follows:

- a) Top 8 bowlers from 7 centres (56 bowlers)
- b) Top 3 bowlers with highest scores from the reserve's list (from all 7 bowling centres)
- c) 1 slot for invited guest from SKL Credit.

7) Handicap

Ladies will be given <u>10 pins</u> per game and men senior 60 - 64 years will be given <u>5 pins</u> per game and 65 years and above will be given <u>7 pins</u> respectively throughout qualifying and final. <u>No additional handicap for lady senior.</u>

8) Verification of Scores

It is the bowler's responsibility to verify the correctness of their scores during qualifying period by signing on the score sheet and return to the bowling counter. Once signed, the scores shall stand unless otherwise decided by the Tournament Director.

9) Masters' Final Fee

All qualifiers are required to make their final fee payment of \$120/- (from 4th to 8th November 2023) at SuperBowl Mt Faber via Pay Now/Cash/Credit card. Reserves will be called on 9th November 2023 and payment must be made by 10th November 2023 by 10pm.

11) Refunds

No refund of entry/final fees will be made after it has been accepted.

11) Masters' Final Check-in Time

Masters' Final will be held at <u>SuperBowl Mount Faber on 12th November 2023 at 10am sharp</u>. All finalists must report personally at the bowling counter **30 minutes** before the scheduled bowling time. The Centre clock shall be the official timepiece. Latecomer is allowed to bowl at the frame which the bowler on his/her respective lane has bowled. Lane will be drawn by SKL representative on tournament day.

12) Tie Breaker

Should a tie occur during qualifying/Masters Final, the player with the least difference between the highest and lowest game bowled shall be the winner. Should there is a further tie, the highest game will be taken in to decide the final standing.

13) Fouls

Protests involving fouls must be brought immediately upon discovery to the attention of officials on duty before the delivery of next ball.

14) Bowler's Attire for <u>Masters' Final</u>

Bowlers are required to be properly and appropriately dressed for bowling. If in the opinion of the Tournament Director that a bowler is not appropriately dressed, he/she may not be permitted to bowl. MALE BOWLERS MUST WEAR PANTS OR SLACKS AND ARE NOT ALLOWED TO WEAR SLEEVELESS SHIRTS AND/OR SHORTS, BERMUDAS. Female bowlers may wear skirts, shorts, pants, slacks and NO TANK TOP.

16) Perfect Game

\$500 will be awarded to the first perfect game achieved during Masters'. Bowler must inform the staff once seven strikes are achieved or it will be invalid.

17) Interrupted Game(s)

a) The Tournament Director may authorize the completion of a game and series on another pair of lanes when equipment failure on the lanes will delay the normal progress of the series. An interrupted game/series that cannot be completed must resume from the point of interruption.

b) In the event of the score of any game is lost/erased and cannot be recalled or traced due to power/ equipment failure, the bowler concerned will be required to re-bowl a new game when the power supply resumes/equipment is repaired. However, all scores of the completed games that have been recorded in the official score sheet shall remain unchanged.

18) Protest

a) Eligibility

A protest involving eligibility and qualifying scores must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Director or his appointed official on duty, not later than 24 hours after the completion of the qualifying in which the protest has arisen.

b) All other protest

When a protest involves the Masters' Final, a protest must be lodged to the Tournament Director or official on the spot. No protests shall be entertained after the presentation of prizes.

c) Error in Scoring

Error in scoring or calculation must be corrected by the responsible official immediately upon discovery. Protests involving scores will be rectified if it's brought upon to the attention of appointed official on duty immediately.

d) Fouls

A protest involving fouls must be brought to the attention of Lane Marshall before the delivery of next ball. No protest will be entertained after the bowler has made his/her second delivery of the frame.

19) Interpretation of Clause

The tournament Director, or in his absence, his appointed official on duty reserves the right to accept or reject any entry as he deems fit.

Any matters that are not covered in these Rules and Regulations, will be decided upon by Tournament Director/SuperBowl Management and shall be final.
